DISTRICT GIFTED UPDATE

- THE GIFTED DISTRICT TEAM WILL:
 - ALIGN K-12 GIFTED PROGRAMMING WITH STATE STATUTES, RULES, AND RESEARCH BASED RECOMMENDATIONS
 - PROVIDE SITE-BASED K-5, 6-8, 9-12 SERVICE DELIVERY MODELS GUIDANCE
 - PROVIDE INSTRUCTIONAL COACHING AND COLLABORATION FOR SPECIALLY DESIGNED INSTRUCTION & DIFFERENTIATION
- GIFTED SCREENING
 - UNIVERSAL 2ND GRADE COGAT GIFTED SCREENING
 - K-8 GIFTED SCREENING USING KBIT-2 OR COGAT ADMINISTERED BY COUNSELORS OR GIFTED SUPPORT
- GIFTED ITINERANTS WILL NO LONGER BE POSITIONED TO PULL STUDENTS FOR ENRICHMENT AND/OR CONSULTATION EACH WEEK
- SECOND GRADE TEACHERS WILL IMPLEMENT THE COGAT GIFTED SCREENER.
- 3 GIFTED INSTRUCTIONAL COACHES WILL PARTNER WITH ALL SCHOOLS TO EMPOWER GIFTED TEACHERS IN:
 - COLLABORATIVE PLANNING AND FACILITATING DIFFERENTIATED LESSONS
 - WRITING GIFTED EDUCATION PLANS
 - CONDUCTING ELIGIBILITY, TRANSFER, & PROGRESSION MEETINGS
 - COMPLETING ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORTS
- **K-5: GIFTED BLEND** GIFTED STUDENTS INTENTIONALLY PLACED FOR DAILY INSTRUCTION WITH A TEACHER WHO HAS EARNED THE GIFTED ENDORSEMENT

• **6-8: ADVANCED-CONTENT** GIFTED STUDENTS INTENTIONALLY PLACED IN A MINIMUM OF ONE COURSE IN THE DAILY SCHEDULE WHICH IS TAUGHT BY A GIFTED-ENDORSED TEACHER.
