Academic, Attendance, Behavior Expectations

- Must be passing ALL core subjects (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Intensive Reading (if enrolled) with a 60% or higher
- Must have no more than 5 unexcused absences from the date of trip registration
- Must exhibit model behavior by following the TCA F.L.O.W. expectations
 - Any Level 3 Offense
 - Out of school suspension
 - No more than 2 instances of any suspension (ISS)

Chaperones
